

Raglan Sweatshirt Pattern


By Shwin Designs for Shwin and Shwin Size 2T (21" Chest 37" height)

Print at 100% do not scale.

Trim white border off the right and bottom edge, then tape the pages together so the gray lines meet and pattern lines match.

Pattern may not be sold, shared or copied.
